Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

(Corpus Christi)

Today we celebrate the gift of the Eucharist, which is the centre, and the origin of the life of the Church. All Eucharistic devotion is related to the sacrifice of the Mass, which perpetuates Jesus' death and resurrection. It is a memorial of the Last Supper and an anticipation of the Messianic banquet in the Kingdom of heaven. Holy Thursday actually marks the anniversary of the institution of the Eucharist. But since it comes at a time when the commemoration of Jesus' passion and death overshadows everything else, the Church has given us this feast to bring out the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday, the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. May we always give thanks to God for this wonderful gift.

"Lord Jesus Christ, we worship you living among us in the sacrament of your Body and Blood. May we offer to our Father in heaven a solemn pledge of undivided love. The Divine Mercy Chaplet

Using normal rosary beads begin with:

Our Father..., Hail Mary..., The Creed.

On the five large beads:

"Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world".

On the 10 small beads:

"For the sake of His sorrowful Passion have mercy on us and on the whole world".

At the end of the Divine Mercy Chaplet say three times:

"Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world".
